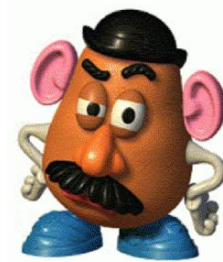

Visual Reminders

-  **Eyes:** Looking when someone talks
-  **Ears:** Listening when someone talks
-  **Mouth:** Quiet
-  **Hands:** To self & Raise to talk
-  **Bottom:** Sitting during group time
-  **Feet:** To self & Walking in class
-  **Heart:** Kind



Learning Routines & Expectations

We talk about:

Respect: respect for other students, property, and adults; listening when someone is talking; sharing and using kind words

Responsibility: raising hands to speak; using quiet voices; following directions, staying on task; doing one's job

Safety: keeping bodies to oneself; being safe and honest; walking to places around the school

Class Dojo

Parents can see how many points are being earned through the Class Dojo website or app. Points are awarded for students caught being good. They will earn special coupons for every 25 points. Coupons range from a trip to the treasure box to special privileges.



Students earn points for the whole class. When the class reaches 500 points, they will receive a special class reward.

Having difficulty?

*Students struggling will have a small conference with the teacher. An expectation sheet will be sent home for the parents to sign and discuss.

*Students who had extreme difficulty may receive a Behavior Slip or RRS slip, which will need to be signed and returned. These slips are part of our school wide system.
